

Douglas County Museum – Field Trip FAQ

1. **What is the best way to schedule?** The education department's hours are very limited; so ideally, scheduling can best be accommodated via email to (museum@co.douglas.or.us). Alternatively, call 541-957-7007 to schedule.
2. **What are the group size limits?** Due to the delicate nature of our exhibits and the small size of our facility, we regret that we must limit the group size for field trips to 50 students or less, plus adult chaperones.
3. **What does the museum charge for field trips?** There is no charge for students from Douglas County schools; adult chaperones are also free – up to 1 adult per every 5 students. Beyond that extra chaperones must pay an admittance fee of \$3.00 per person (normal adult admittance is \$8.00). For groups from outside Douglas County, the charge is \$2.00 per student and \$3.00 for each adult.
4. **Are guided tours available?** Yes, on a case by case basis. Our docents are volunteers, and as such, are not always available for tours. We do have a great self-guided tour document available for use.
5. **Are supplemental learning materials available?** Yes! We have documents online for use before or after your visit to the museum. We also have a wonderful BINGO Scavenger hunt for use during your visit.
